RULES

- Horses must be ridden by the same competitor throughout all phases of the challenge.
- If riding more than one horse in an event - the order of horses to be ridden must be received with noms. **Each rider is limited to three horses**
- Horse must be ridden in a snaffle bit.
- All competitors must complete a QCAS Biosecurity Horse Health & Movement Declaration before competing, for each horse.
- Nominations must be received by **Monday 19th May 2025 at 5pm**. All fees **MUST** be paid before competing. Nomination & stable /electric fence booking form:

- Stallions not to be ridden by anyone under 17 years of age.
- All competitors under 18 years of age must wear protective headwear to the current Australian standard.
- A **mini** is a competitor 5 - 8 years. A **junior** is a competitor 9 - 12 Years. A **Juvenile** is 13 - 17 years.
- All competitors ride at their own risk & must complete an Alpha Show Waiver Form, Under 18 competitors must have the form completed by a parent / guardian
- Judge's decision is FINAL.
- Scratchings accepted until **Monday 19th May 2025 at 5pm**, otherwise forfeit nomination fee.
- Trophies for highest score over three events in all classes, encouragement award in each class.
- Program subject to timing changes at the discretion of Alpha Show Society.

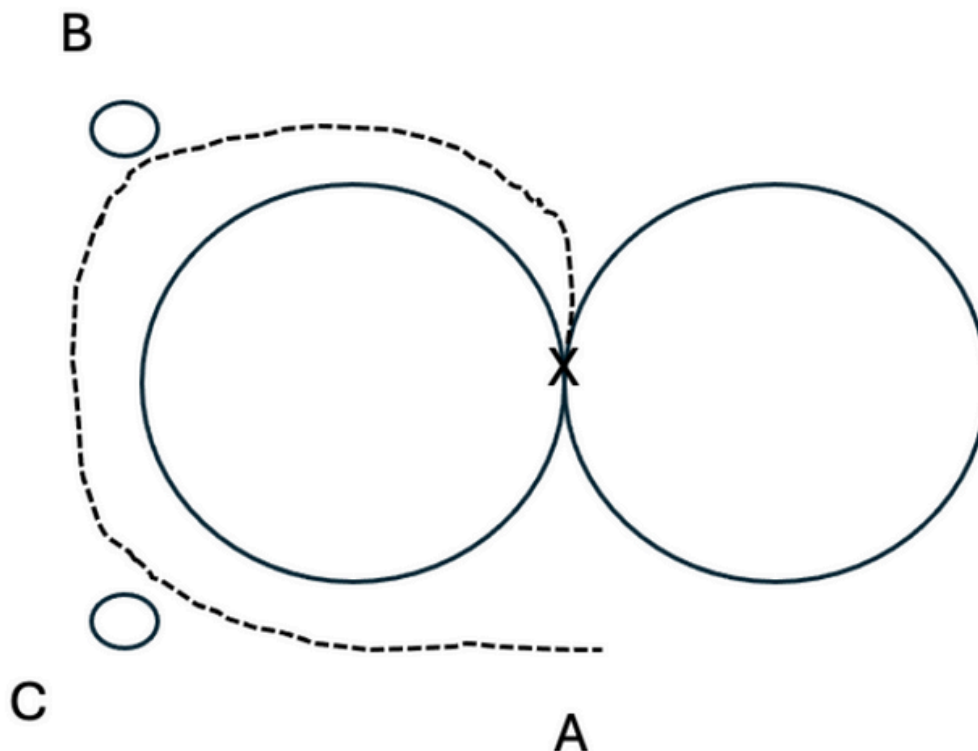

1	Type, Presentation & Overall Impression	10
2	Starting at A, walk in a straight line to X	10
3	At X trot a medium circle to the right	10
4	At X trot a medium circle to the left	10
5	At X continue trotting a large circle to B	10
6	Pick up flag and carry to C	10
7	Place flag on C obstacle	10
8	Walk from C to A	10
9	Stop and let horse settle	10
10	Back up 2 steps. Acknowledge the Judge	10

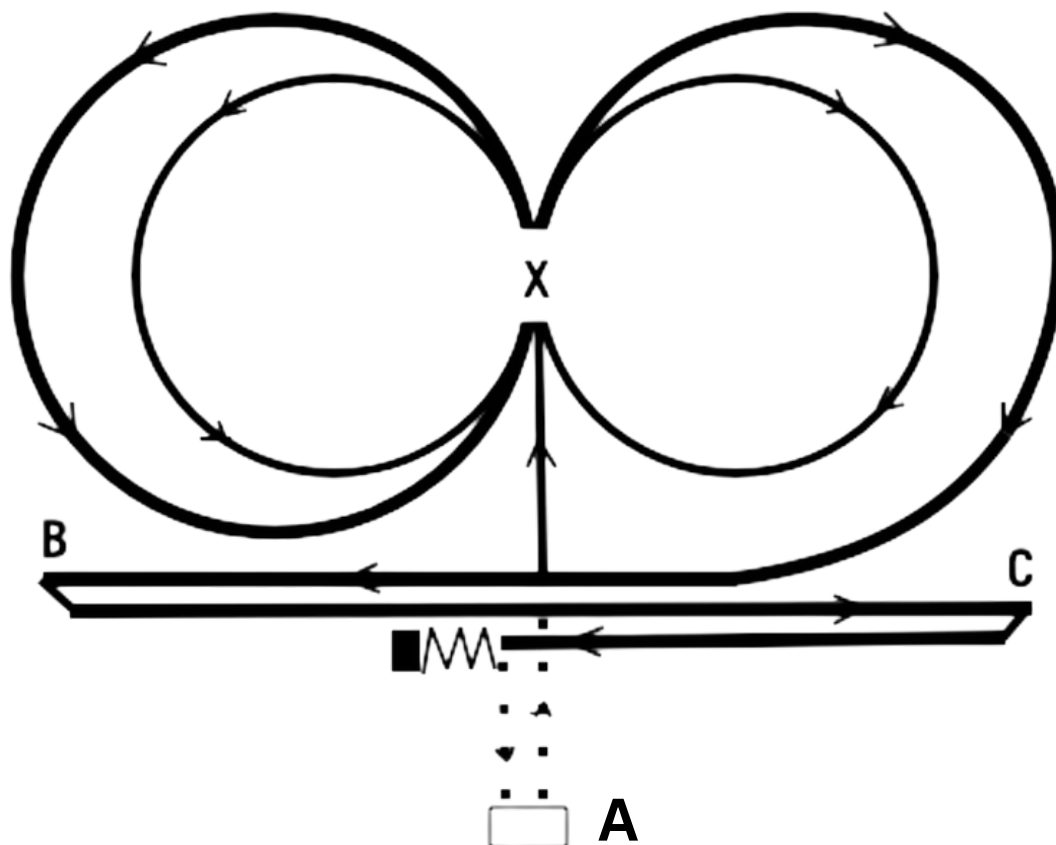

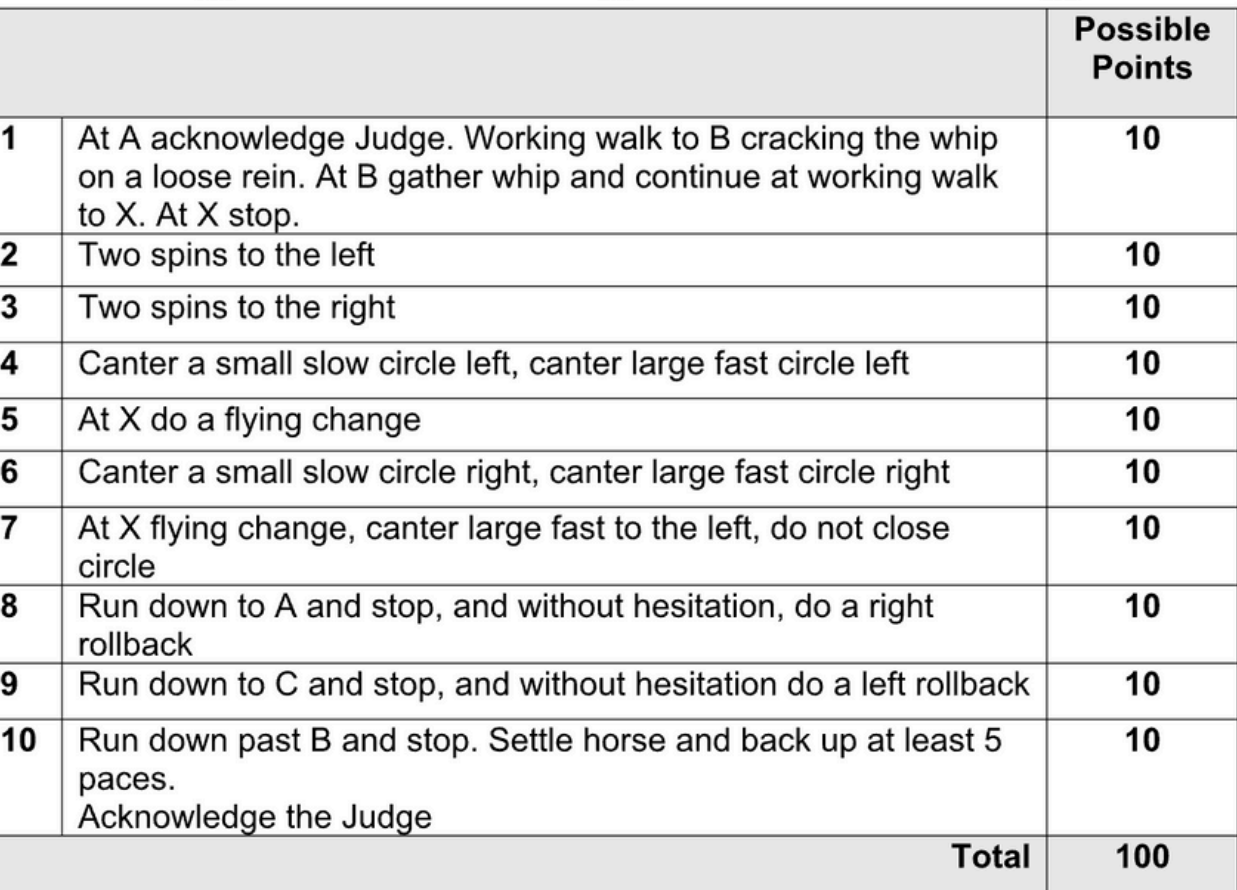

1	Type, Presentation & Overall impression	10
2	Walk a short distance, at X canter a small circle left	10
3	At X gallop a large circle left	10
4	Flying change at X	10
5	Canter small slow circle right	10
6	At X gallop right, continue to B	10
7	Stop at B, roll back left and gallop to C	10
8	Roll back right	10
9	Gallop past centre circle line, stop and settle	10
10	Rein back 3 metres and walk to Judge on loose rein	10

START / FINISH

Course	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Starting at the starting line go straight through the four jumps Start the bending poles with the first pole on the near side of your horse (LEFT) Complete a right-hand barrel pattern At the completion of your third barrel, continue straight through the bending pegs with the first peg on your near side (LEFT) Over the jumps and across the finish line 	
Note <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Mini competitors jumps will be a wooden rail on the ground 	
Penalties	
Three seconds	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Any peg or obstacle knocked down or dislodged Any obstacle the judge deems to be sufficiently moved Not negotiating the obstacle correctly
Elimination	Any section of the course not completely negotiated
