- The following classes are open to those under the age of 25 yrs on 1st of May in the year of the show.
- Schools Competition requires a team of 3 students, enrolled at a school.
- Competitors under the age of 18 years must have approval from parents/guardians to enter. It is the responsibility of the parents/guardians to make arrangements on behalf of the competitor to take responsibility of their safety while competing in this event.
- Points will be allocated for correct animal assessment, speaking ability, description of animals, presentation and dress.
- Entrants in Junior or Senior Parade Classes enter at their own risk, entrants are responsible for any injury/damage to competitor or beast.
- Local winners or the highest local point winner is eligible for the CHASS Finals.
- NB: Age groups may be combined/split at stewards discretion depending on numbers.
- Order of events: Stud Cattle - 8.30am, Led Steer/Heifer, Junior Judges Paraders Competition, Stud Cattle - Young Judges, Prime Cattle - Young Judges Competition
- All Judging will take place at the Showgrounds
